- A Co: Continued PAS (Patrol and Surveillance) operations in vicinity of current location with negative results. The recon teams & sniper teams employed with company.
- B Co: Inserted on FSB Granite for one platoon to stay on FSB Granite and help secure it while the other teams conduct patrol and surveillance operations off to the southeast & southwest. Inserted as a reaction to sapper attack.
- C Co: At 0204 hrs, C Co and FSB Granite came under a sapper attack. They received heavy RPG & small arms fire and received mortar fire. The attack lasted until 0410 hrs. Total friendly casualties were 10 KIA, and 31 MIA.
- D Co: Continued patrol and surveillance operations in vicinity of current location with negative results. Recon & sniper teams employed with Co.
